1. 授業のねらい・概要 Course Description

The goal of this course is to engage students in intermediate-level English as it is used in communication among native speakers. The lessons are divided according to topic-based readings and vocabulary. Since this course is a part of the nursing school curriculum, there will be an emphasis on health-related topics.

Upon completing this course, students can expect to have an increased level of confidence in using English in daily life situations which require them to use English in an international setting, or to communicate with native English speakers.
