1. 授業のねらい・概要 Course Aims

The aim of Core English is to increase students' ability to communicate in English about daily life topics and current events. This course also aims to provide a foundation for further English study, such as for the Eiken or TOEIC tests, or for traveling abroad.

Students will have Core English twice per week. They will be with the same classmates and have the same instructor for the whole year. In each class, students will engage in topic-based conversation, listening, grammar and vocabulary exercises aimed at improving their knowledge of English as well as their communications skills.
